Built on the site of a WWII bombing test range, the Armourgeddon Military Museum is a remarkable collection of tanks, military vehicles, guns, canons and interactive displays, guaranteed to delight.

The Armourgeddon Military Museum began life as a curious collection of military vehicles. Growing across a number of hangers, the museum has been developed to provide an insight into life during the war years, with the intention of preserving and interpreting our cultural and national heritage.

Entering the Museum, you will immediately be thrown back to 1944 and a street scene complete with Normandy café and convoy of allied military vehicles. Opposite the café, a glimpse of life in the UK during WWII with a genuine Anderson Shelter. Re-built by a team of Venture Scouts local to the Museum, the shelter marks the entrance to a set of displays donated by ex-service personnel and their families.



Through to the next hanger and the tanks grow in size. Our collection will reveal some vehicles that saw service in the Cold War from both sides of the Iron Curtain, in Northern Ireland, Iraq and North Africa.



Interactive displays exist throughout the collection. Dress up in service uniform, hold an AK47 assault rifle, Oozy submachine gun and other rifles, sit inside Command Post AFV439 to send a message, listen to a fire mission or take a compass reading.



Complete your visit back in the Café de Normandie with hot and cold drinks, soups, sandwiches and sweet treats, listening to the soundtrack of the 1940s or watching the tanks put through their paces on the tracks at the weekend.
